The volume is in the lower leg — great to balance out curves in the bust and hips. So the more voluptuous you are, the wider you can go with the flare.

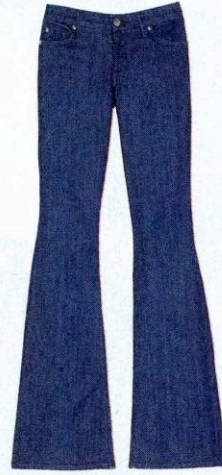

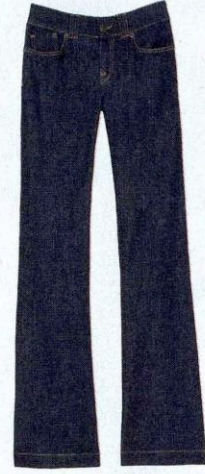

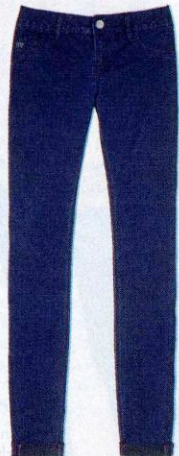
The good thing about this style: It comes in variations. Lean gals, try baggy ones that will hang off your hips. Short? A skinny version is best.
